# What is EQUIPPED Discipleship Program?

*“So Christ himself gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.” Ephesians 4:11-13, NLT*

At The Family Church, we are committed to equipping and resourcing the body of Christ to be able to walk in the fullness of the abundant life Jesus promised in the Bible. The EQUIPPED Discipleship Program is one of the ways we sow into that commitment.

Our desire is to raise up followers of Christ who understand the foundation of their faith, and the spiritual authority they carry, are healthy and whole, dream God-sized dreams, and are empowered to change the culture of their cities and world with the power and love of God. We do this through strengthening them with Biblical Foundation, increasing their understanding of Identity and ability to appropriate the Spiritual Gifts, and equipping them with Kingdom Tools and excellent Leadership Training.

**Program Goals:** The Discipleship Program has four goals:

- Develop solid understanding of accurate, historical, and contextual biblical foundation;
- Solidify understanding of identity;
- Empower believers to know the spiritual authority they carry;
- Launch people into their destiny as influencers, leaders, and world changers.

This is fulfilled through an eight-month program of intentional classroom learning with discussion, ministry involvement, and practical hands-on experience:

*“Always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you.” 1 Peter 3:15b, NKJ*

## Who is the Discipleship Program for?

### 1. Those Who Desire to Grow in Their Foundation and Walk as a Christian

If you want to learn how to walk in the fullness and truth of your Identity; solid Biblical foundation; greater understanding and appropriation of Spiritual Gifts; expand your experience of Kingdom Creativity; and be better equipped to lead others, this is the program for you!

## 2. Those Who Desire Leadership Equipping

If you are currently involved in a ministry, leading a ministry, or just desire to learn how to more effectively lead others effectively, this program is for you. The Discipleship Program is designed to help you experiment, experience and explore aspects of leadership through practical training in Leadership Principles, development and understanding of Supernatural gifts, learning to exercise Spiritual Influence, all based on solid biblical foundation.

## 3. Those Applying for Licensing/Ordination

As a licensed religious institution, The Family Church has the legal ability and authority to license and ordain those qualified to minister the Gospel. Licensing is a way for the local church to give recognition, authorization and affirmation of a person's gifts, skills, and ability for ministry, and acknowledges the call of spiritual leadership on a person's life. Licensing is granted through recommendation (upon application review) of the Family Church Pastoral Licensing Review Board and is typically provided to lay persons who have the gift and ability to preach, teach, minister, and lead as defined by the Family Church Licensing Requirements. The Discipleship Program one of the Family Church's key requirements to be licensed as a pastor.

### Discipleship Program Graduation Requirements:

- Complete all four Discipleship Class series (24 classes), including class participation and homework assignments;
- Schedule and complete one Inner Healing Appointment (team or private);
- Attend Leadership meetings at The Family Church;
- Participate in All-Church Events: Easter, Fireworks booths, Fall Kickoff, Worship Nights, Thanksgiving Dinner, Holiday Decorating/Chili Cook-off, Christmas event/service;
- Attend and observe (in entirety) three different ministry service/events: Children's, Spot Youth, Men/Women's Life Group, Home Group/Bible Study, Welcome Table, Ushers, Greeters, Intercessory Prayer, Altar Ministry, Spirit Café, Intercessory Prayer, Response Team, or Healing Room.
